## BOARD BRIEFS

### RESIGNATION

Secretary/Treasurer Terrance McTarnaghan has resigned from the Board of Directors due to personal reasons. Terrance has been a valuable member of the Board over the last 15 months and his contributions are greatly appreciated.

### LES GERHART JOINS THE BOARD

Les Gerhart has been appointed to the Board of Directors to serve the remaining term of Terrance McTarnaghan. Les is a prior member of the Board and we welcome him back from his period of retirement. And a big thank you from us for his willingness to once again give back to the Myrtle Trace community.

### DREDGING UPDATE

The Lake Estate Management team has completed the dredging of a small portion of Lake Oriole, Lake Cormorant and Lake Sparrow. The workers will go to Berry Tree Lane again to dredge the small portion of Lake Oriole that abuts the golf course. When it is time to do the large open portion of Lake Oriole a different piece of equipment will be used. It is a very slow process. The silt is collected in a drainage bag and when the water has completely drained from the bag, the bag is opened, the silt and debris is removed and taken off site.

### ADULT LAP SWIM TIME

The Property Committee recommended and the Board approved a designated Lap Swim Time from 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily. Children will not be allowed in the pool during this time. A copy of the revised Myrtle Trace Pool Rules is included in this month's issue of *News & Views*. Please place the new rules in the MTHOA Guidelines & Policies three-ring binder under TAB B, in the Appendix section of Property Guidelines. The sheet with the revised Pool Rules has been hole punched for you.

### ANONYMOUS COMPLAINTS

Recently, there have been several anonymous complaints about the business practices of a local service provider. These complaints have been in the form of notices posted at the Clubhouse and other Common Property locations and e-mails to numerous residents. The specific complaint deals with transactions between a Myrtle Trace resident and the service provider. The Board of Directors has no role in such a transaction. The Board of Directors will not condone the posting of derogatory statements regarding any service provider in the community. The MTHOA has no legal right to ban any organization from doing business in Myrtle Trace. And furthermore, the Board will not react or respond to any anonymous complaint.

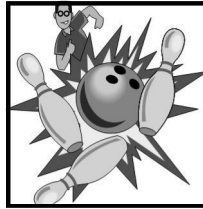
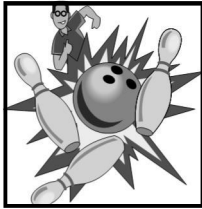

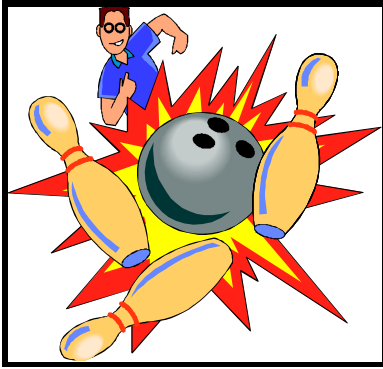
