The regularly scheduled board meeting for September was canceled due to unknown effects of Hurricane Florence on the Myrtle Trace infrastructure and availability of board members and committee chairs. The meeting was rescheduled to Wednesday, September 26th several days AFTER the deadline date for submitting articles to News & Views. The November Board of Directors meeting will be held on the Wednesday, November 14th at 9:00 a.m. The date change is being made as the third Wednesday happens to fall the day before Thanksgiving.

HURRICANE FLORENCE BEFORE & AFTER

Several steps were taken in hopes of lessening the potential impact of Hurricane Florence should she make a hit in the Conway area. The Board authorized the rental of a pump to lower retention ponds: Heron; Bunting; and Oriole. Hardee maintenance pulled boards from the outflows, cleaned out swales and removed three pumps to prevent damage. They also removed or turned over sitting area benches. In addition, several members of the Property Committee and the community took down pool umbrellas and moved table and chairs to the cabana storeroom.

As always, during storm lulls and following Florence, members of our Myrtle Trace community were out helping fellow Myrtle Tracers. Some acts of kindness involved: taking branches off roofs; patching a roof to prevent water leaks; residents assisting another by stopping by with a chain saw to help cut up a tree limb which had fallen; and a resident helping Karleen Hardee rake up debris in the pool area. I am sure there were many more instances where Myrtle Tracers were helping Myrtle Tracers. Thanks to all of you who helped, this is what makes Myrtle Trace the best community in Conway.

During and after Florence arrived in our area, Al Hardee and many of his crew were in Myrtle Trace everyday including Saturday and Sunday checking for pieces of debris or trees down on the roads. They started raking pine straw and debris from common grounds on Saturday and loading up storm debris residents had placed on their front yards. We owe a big thank you to the Hardee Maintenance team; they have worked long and hard to get Myrtle Trace back in shape. Unfortunately, some residents took unfair advantage of the pick-up and decided to trim trees and shrubbery and add it to the storm debris. This added to their already exhausting work load of picking up storm debris from 518 residences and raking and cleaning up all common areas. The next time you see a member of Hardee Maintenance, thank them for all they have done in such a short period of time to clean up Myrtle Trace.
