ITEMS FOR BOARD ACTION

The Board of Directors recommends the addition of two clauses to the Owner/Tenant Form and Agreement. The two clauses are:

During the term of the rental agreement, if there is a change in the number of tenants who will be full

time occupants in the residence, the Owner must submit to the Accounts Receivable Consultant a
written statement listing the changes including: name, relationship and date of birth. This infor-
mation including additional occupant(s) or occupant(s) who will no longer be occupying the resi-
dence must be done within ten days of the change.
Owner(s) Initials: Tenant(s)
In accordance with Article VII, section 1 of the covenants, at least one individual listed on the
rental agreement must be at least fifty five (55) and reside full time in the rental property. Should
conditions change where no individual listed on the rental agreement meets this criteria, the rental
agreement must be terminated. The property Owner must advise the remaining tenant(s), that they
must vacate the property within thirty (30) days. Failure of the Owner to do so and tenant still in
rental after thirty (30) days will result in the property owner(s) being assessed a fine of \$500.00 dol-
lars. Additional fines of ten dollars (\$10.00) a day shall be assessed against the property owner(s)
until tenants have vacated the property.
