BOARD BRIEFS

BOARD ACTION TAKEN

The Board approved a recommended policy on guest parking of Trucks, RVs, and/or Campers as proposed at the July 20th meeting of the Board of Directors. The approved policy is as follows:

POLICY on TRUCKS, RVS AND CAMPER PARKING

Overnight guests of residents, who own a truck, RV, or camper must obtain a parking permit and park the vehicle in the Pear Tree Circle area. The vehicle permit is for parking only; it is not to be occupied while in the parking area. The guests are to reside with the Myrtle Trace resident during their stay in Myrtle Trace. Violation of this policy is subject to the System of Fines for Trucks/Recreational Vehicle Parking.

The proposed policy was published in the August issue of the *News & Views*. The actual approved guideline is being published in the September issue of *News and Views* making the change enforceable and in compliance with the Board Policy on Publication Notice.
