ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE – Pat Hosford submitted revised ARC Guidelines to the Board.

Susan Granger moved and Bob Ebling seconded the motion to accept the ARC Reports as written. The motion passed unanimously.

PROPERTY COMMITTEE – Cathy McElroy gave the Board a packet concerning the aerator on Lake Bunting.

Susan Granger moved and Dusty Rhodes seconded the motion to postpone any decision on Lake Bunting until a later date. The motion passed unanimously.

Bob Ebling moved and Deborah Rebocho seconded the motion to accept the Property Committee Report with one correction. Bradford Pear trees will be taken down and replaced with Crepe Myrtles. Crepe Myrtles will not be removed. The motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

- ➤ **Update on Signs in the Copy Room –** Two new signs have been installed in the Copy Room stating that the fire lane must be kept clear at ALL times.
- Discussion and Vote on Addition to Policy on Planting on Common Ground Around Mailbox Posts – The proposed change to the policy was published in the "News and Views" last month.

Susan Granger moved and Dusty Rhodes seconded the motion to approve a change to the current policy and add that reflectors must be visible. The motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

➤ Antennas for Emergency Radios – Some residents have made requests to ARC to allow the installation of antennas on their homes for emergency radios. MTHOA covenants restrict this at this time. To be able to change the ARC Guidelines, the Board needs to do a waiver to accept these antennas. Todd Rush brought an example of the antenna. They would not be visible from the street. These antennas allow the owners to communicate with the Emergency Operation Centers in Conway, Myrtle Beach and Columbia if necessary.

Susan Granger moved and Bob Ebling seconded the motion to waive the Covenant restriction on antennas (Article 7, Section 7) for licensed amateur emergency service only to allow for review and approval by ARC. The motion passed unanimously.

- Budget Progress Report Bob Ebling said It is progressing.
- Nominating Committee and Annual Meeting Agenda Susan Granger said the committee will meet in September to begin the process. The 2024 Annual Meeting is on February 3rd at HGTC.
- ➤ Camera at the Back Gate Nancy Seeds explained the Board is looking into the possibility of a camera that does not require Wi-Fi.
