BOARD BRIEFS

The November 17, 2021 MTHOA Board of Directors Meeting was constructive and informative. The Emergency Contact Form.. This form is held under lock and key by the MTHOA Board. It is very **IMPORTANT** if something serious happens to a resident. It allows us to contact family or persons who have knowledge of your personal wishes. Please follow the directions.

The Vial of Life. This is kept in your home on the refrigerator. Please include information about your pet/s (name/s, Vets name & number)

LAST CHANCE: ANY GROUP wishing to use the Clubhouse on a repeat basis which is not connect-ed with the Myrtle Trace Activities Committee and wants to have their activity on the calendar must provide name of the group, a contact person, day of the week and time requesting the use of the Clubhouse to Pat Paxson by December 15, 2021.

BOARD ACTION TO BE TAKEN

Rewording of the policy for GATE PASS DECALS:

Gate pass decals are available to all residents (homeowners and rental tenants) whose vehicles are reg-istered at their Myrtle Trace residence. Residents may request a gate decal which is placed on the vehicle by a representative of the Association and show a copy of the registration. New homeowner may obtain a gate decal once the Association Representative has received confirmation that the closing of the property has taken place. Likewise, new rental tenants are eligible to obtain a gate decal once the Association representative has received confirmation of receipt of an Owner/Tenant Agreement.

Absentee homeowners will be issued a gate pass decal only if they reside in Myrtle Trace for at least four (4) months of the year and provided the property is not rented. Decals are not transferable and should not be removed from the vehicle until the vehicle is traded, sold, or no longer at the Myrtle Trace residence. When residents who have decals get a new vehicle they must have a new decal placed on the vehicle once it is reg-istered at the Myrtle Trace residence.

To request a gate pass decal contact the Association Representative listed on the back of the Myrtle Trace Directory.

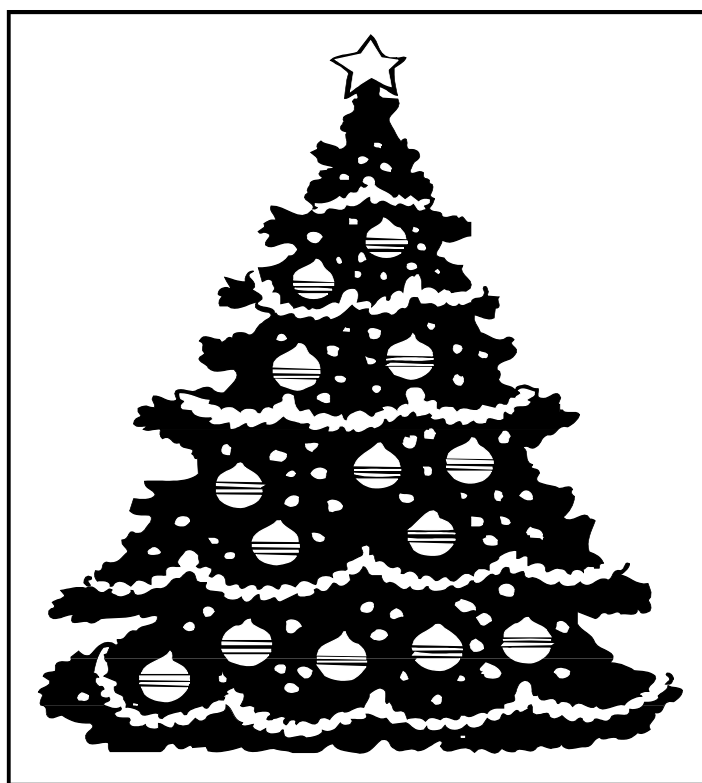
